As part of your child's work in GCSE History, a visit has been arranged to see a theatre production of Hitler on Trial. Hitler on Trial opens with an 'exam-busting workshop' in which students discover the thinking behind the GCSE exam, and find out how to make the most of their knowledge and skills. This is followed by a mock trial in which Adolf Hitler is charged with causing the Second World War. Prosecution and Defence Counsels question nine witnesses whose testimony, which ranges across international relations 1919-39 as well as the history of Nazi Germany, offers two contrasting interpretations of the causes of the Second World War.
