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# Digital Communication & Information Update on Developments

## **College Website**

Our Web & Electronic Media Manager, Mr J Marshall, has recently launched the new look website, <u>www.landau-forte.org.uk</u>. Here you can easily find such useful information as Parent/Carer Letters, Academic Year Dates, Termly Calendar of Events and headlines of recent events at the College. Please take the opportunity to view our Learning at Landau video produced by our students and recently winning a competition for the Specialist Schools and Academies Trust. Feedback on our website design and user friendliness is always welcome. Please use the Contact section of the website to send us your views.

### **College App**

In January we launch a customised Landau Forte College app. We hope this will further support effective communication with our Students/Parents/Carers and wider community. The app is free and provides access to the College's Calendar of Events, latest news and will have the capacity to report your child's absence and contact the College directly. The app will also alert you, via push notifications, to important information for you and your child.

#### ParentPay

More and more of our Parents are using ParentPay as an effective way of paying for College meals, instrumental tuition or visits. Clearly, this system is effective in reducing administration costs, allowing us to target resources effectively into student support. Over time we intend this system to replace completely any other payment processes.

## Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

Currently in development, the College is trialling visitor and student use of their own electronic devices in the building and safely connecting to the network. This project is in the early stages of development and has not been without challenges. However, we hope to work towards a position where this will be widely available.

#### **Mobile Phones**

A reminder of the College policy with respect to mobile phones. Students are encouraged to use their mobile phones appropriately within the building and during College time. The College policy, over time has adapted to the 'real world' use of mobile technology as a learning resource. Increasingly, phones are used in learning sessions as they are a valuable resource for learning.

## **E-Safety**

The College remains committed to educating the students in their safe use of online technology. Students in Year 9 have recently seen a production of Chelsea's Choice, which covers the content of sexual exploitation and online communication. The College has trained 100 students as peer mentors with part of their responsibilities to act as cyber mentors. To link with this, the focus of College Gatherings in this term will be cyber bullying.
