Enrichment 2016 (4 – 8 July) – Year 12

During the College Enrichment programme, launched with the students in a Gathering during this term, Year 12 students have a number of opportunities.

Programme 1: They may be completing their **Silver Duke of Edinburgh** expedition or a week of their **Work Placement** entitlement.

Programme 2: For all other students in Year 12, the week gives them the opportunity to be involved in one of or more of the **activities** shown on the **table overleaf**.

These activities enable Year 12 students to work alongside the tutorial staff, supporting younger students. In previous years our Year 12 students have found this experience enjoyable and very worthwhile. Many have used this opportunity to enhance their CV or their 'personal statement' for their university application. It is expected that students will make a commitment to at least one activity but they may take part in more than one activity if they wish. They must not commit to activities taking place at the same time and it is hoped that their chosen activity will match their specialist subject areas or their interests.

Year 12 students will complete an application for their preferred activity during Tutor Time early this term. For some activities there will be an additional cost; where appropriate this will be a contribution towards entrance fees, travel and/or accommodation.
