I am pleased to inform you that your son/daughter has secured a place on the residential to Mount Cook Activity Centre in Matlock leaving on Monday 9 October 2017 and returning on Tuesday 10 October 2017.

Students must arrive at College at the usual time as the day will begin at 8.30am with a series of three workshops designed to focus the students on revision through a growth mind-set. We will be leaving the College at 11.30am and arriving at the Centre at 12.30am. Students need to take a packed lunch on the first day. If your son/daughter has free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided for them. The three meals that they receive after this have been included in the price.

The students will return from the Centre on Tuesday 10 October 2017, leaving at 1.00pm and arriving at the College at 2.00pm. They will be met by a member of the Executive Team and dismissed soon after. If you wish your child to stay in College until 3.15pm, please indicate this on the form below.

Learning outside the classroom offers new and exciting challenges and students will learn to work together as a team, develop independence, confidence and an ability to recognise strengths and weaknesses in a constructive way. The value of giving young people the opportunity to try out new activities cannot be underestimated.

At Mount Cook Activity Centre fully trained and qualified instructors, with the support of school staff, provide instruction in a full programme of activities in a safe, controlled and secure environment. The activities available include: High Ropes, Climbing Wall, Archery, Fencing and a Night Walk. However, these will be interspersed with revision activities preparing students for their GCSE examinations. The purpose of the trip is to encourage the students to become more self-aware, developing a growth mind-set and exploring ways in which they can target improvement in their studies. Your son/daughter will return having completed a revision timetable, next step targets and have a clearer understanding of the barriers they experience to learning and how to break them down. Please discuss this with your child once they return. The resources we use will also be available on the school's website once the residential is complete.
