Beyond Shame

JLH - Karma Nirvana, who support victims of honour-based abuse and forced marriage, joined forces with Derby Theatre to create a cutting edge production to raise awareness of forced marriages and the effect that it has on its victims. The excellent '**Beyond Shame**' production, and follow up workshop, was delivered to an audience of female students in Years 10-13 on Monday.



Karma Nirvana run a national helpline that, since its inception in 2008, has received over 68,000 calls for help. Forced Marriage has been a criminal offence since 2014. There were 51 new cases in Derby in 2017 and, of these:

- 10 were aged 17 and under
- 14 were aged from 18 to 24 (4 were male and 11 were female)
- all cases involved Honour-Based Abuse and 50% involved Forced Marriage.
