Thank you for confirming your child's attendance to the year 7 residential. I am writing to provide you with some key information regarding the residential which will soon be taking place. Your child will attend the Year 7 residential from **Wednesday 5 December to Friday 7 December.** Students will need to be in College at 8.30am on Monday morning and will need to bring a **packed lunch** to have once they arrive at Lea Green. If your Child is eligible for free school meals we will provide a packed lunch. They will return to College at 3.00pm on Wednesday. Please make arrangements to pick up your child at this time. On Thursday 6 and Friday 7 December your child will be required to attend College as normal.

The majority of activities at Lea Green are outdoor and therefore it is essential that students have the correct clothing.
