<p><b>Students applying for HE</b> Continuing on from the work completed in Term 5 of Year 12, this term is focused on researching post-18 options, completing personal statements and applying to university via UCAS, with a particular emphasis on those students who need to meet the early UCAS deadline.</p> <p><b>Students applying for Apprenticeships</b> This term will be focused on research and signing up to relevant alerts.</p> <p><b>NB</b> Some students will be applying for university and apprenticeships simultaneously and will complete both sets of activities.</p>	<p><b>Students applying for HE</b> The focus from Term 1 continues as students complete and send their UCAS applications for the January deadline.</p> <p>Students who have completed their applications for the early deadline use this time to prepare for admissions test and/or interviews using range of internet resources.</p> <p><b>Students applying for Apprenticeships</b> This term students will start creating CVs, whilst continuing with their research. One-to-one support on application strategy will be available. Students will start applying for suitable apprenticeships as they begin to go live.</p>	<p><b>Students applying for HE</b> In this term the emphasis turns to financial matters including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can I afford to go to university?</li> <li>• Understanding tuition fee and maintenance loans</li> <li>• Scholarships and bursaries</li> <li>• Registering and completing Student Finance England (SFE) application when it goes live</li> <li>• Budgeting: shopping, rent, household bills etc.</li> </ul> <p><b>Students applying for Apprenticeships</b> Students continue to apply for relevant vacancies. One-to-one support on application strategy and interviews will be available. They will also take part in the budgeting activities as detailed above.</p>	<p><b>Students applying for HE</b> The final term very much focuses on life at university with sessions on the support available at university and wellbeing at university.</p> <p>Students then receive some key information on domestic independence including: cooking, cleaning, washing and food safety</p> <p><b>Students applying for Apprenticeships</b> Students applying for apprenticeships also take part in the domestic independence sessions as well as continuing with their applications.</p>

<p><b>How will learning be assessed and progress measured?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This will be assessed by the students meeting the relevant external deadlines and their successful applications.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Extension and enrichment activities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Small group and individual mentoring by L4L Tutor for students applying for apprenticeships and/or employment as follow up to L4L sessions</li> <li>• Visit to an East Midlands university for a tour and master class</li> <li>• Careers focused Wednesday afternoon sessions with external speakers e.g. Nestle, Atkinsons, BT, HE providers</li> <li>• Mock interviews for university interviews, including Oxbridge, Medicine, Nursing etc.</li> <li>• Mock interviews for apprenticeships</li> </ul>
