# **Curriculum organisation**

Students are taught through ten sessions across two weeks by three learning tutors. The content is separated into: grammar, film and literature, and topics

### Term 1:

- Discuss the positive and negative influence of the internet

#### Term 2:

- Understand the context behind the film El Laberinto del Fauno and begin to understand cinematic techniques
- Analyse themes within a film and how these are represented
- Analyse and discuss the role of celebrity in popular culture including singers and musicians and TV and cinema stars

- Understanding regional differences in Spain
